

CANNABIS HEALTH CERTIFICATE

Program Description

The Cannabis Health Certificate is a 12 credit-hour program that introduces students to a scholarly examination of the role of cannabis in individual and public health. Students completing this certificate will develop knowledge from diverse sources in health; cannabis chemistry; cannabis law and policy; and sociology for the improvement of population health.

Program Learning Outcomes

Graduates will be able to:

- Synthesize knowledge from diverse sources in health; cannabis chemistry; cannabis law and policy; and sociology for the improvement of population health.
- Evaluates research for potential application for evidence based practice in cannabis health.
- Investigate cannabis information related to the health of diverse populations.
- Analyze health cannabis policies, including financial, legal and regulatory, directly and indirectly influencing the nature and functioning of the healthcare system.
- Develop communication and collaboration among health professionals for safety of current and future cannabis use.
