Program Description

The Special Education Learning Disabilities Minor prepares people to work with students with learning disabilities in grades K-12. The minor may be paired with an education program to pursue the learning disabilities special education endorsement on a teaching certificate, taken as a stand-alone program for current teachers for current teachers to add the learning disabilities special education endorsement to an existing teaching certificate, or taken as a stand-alone minor for students who are not following a teaching career pathway, but want to know about working with students with special needs in any setting.
