

INTER-DISCIPLINARY (INTD)

INTD 103 Career Exploration 1 Credit Hour

Career exploration will first be done through online research and interviewing people in the field and then at least 15 hours of job shadowing will be part of the course. 1

INTD 104 Intrnshp/Job Shadow Experience 1 Credit Hour

Students will complete 30+ hours through one or more internship or job shadow placements related to their major or intended major. 1

INTD 310 Foreign Study 1-16 Credit Hours

Individual extension added based on student's program. (1-16)

INTD 320 Foreign Study 3-16 Credit Hours

Individual extension added based on student's program. 3-16 credit/no credit

INTD 333 The Origins of Human Nature 4 Credit Hours (4,0)

An integrated, interdisciplinary examination of the origins of human nature from the perspective of contemporary evolutionary theory, ethology and biological anthropology. The course examines the origins of - among other phenomena - sexual behavior, marriage and family life, crime, social stratification, leadership, government, politics, patriotism, nationalism, racism, ethnocentrism, aggression, genocide, war, ideology and morality.

Prerequisite(s): a college biology course or PSYC101, one college course from each of two social science disciplines (anthropology, economics, political science, psychology, sociology), and junior standing

INTD 410 Foreign Study 3-16 Credit Hours

Individual extension added based on student's program. 3-16 (Graded)

INTD 420 Foreign Study 3-16 Credit Hours

Individual extension added based on student's program. 3-16 credit/no credit

INTD 490 Senior Directed Study 3,4 Credit Hours (3-4,0)

This course is designed to allow liberal studies majors the opportunity to develop and implement a project/paper using the skills and knowledge from their previous course work. Projects/papers should relate to the student's individual areas of study, and represent a synthesis of their previous learning under the supervision of an appropriate faculty member.
