MUSIC (MUSC)

MUSC 101 Pep Band 1 Credit Hour (0,2)

Pep Band offers the opportunity to learn a variety of musical pieces and perform at LSSU events such as athletic competitions and student life celebrations. Students do not have to take this course to be in Pep Band, but this course will provide additional learning opportunities in music compared to participation in Pep Band. May be repeated for up to a maximum of 4 credits.

MUSC 112 Band 1 Credit Hour (0,3)

Open to all University students. The concert band performs representative band and wind ensemble literature and provides a challenging musical experience.

MUSC 113 Band 1 Credit Hour (0,3)

Open to all University students. The concert band performs representative band and wind ensemble literature and provides a challenging musical experience.

MUSC 120 Introduction to Music I 3 Credit Hours (3,0)

An introduction to the basic vocabulary of music and to basic musicianship skills. Topics include notation, meter, rhythm, intervals, scales, chords, etc.

Prerequisite(s): None

MUSC 121 Introduction to Music II 3 Credit Hours (3,0)

The course expands upon the musical vocabulary and skills developed in MUSC120. Topics include C-clefs, seventh chord, non-harmonic tones, cadences, etc.

Prerequisite(s): MUSC120

MUSC 140 Choir 1 Credit Hour (0,3)

Rehearsal and performance of representative literature for mixed choir in both classical and contemporary styles of choral music. May be repeated for a total of eight credits.

MUSC 170 Class Piano I 1 Credit Hour (0,2)

Beginning piano techniques. Music reading ability helpful but not required.

MUSC 171 Class Piano II 1 Credit Hour (0,2)

To improve proficiency and techniques gained in MUSC170. **Prerequisite(s):** MUSC170

MUSC 180 Class Guitar I 1 Credit Hour (0,2)

Introduction to guitar playing including knowledge of musical rudiments, left and right hand techniques and ensemble performance.

MUSC 181 Class Guitar II 1 Credit Hour (0,2)

Course emphasizes increasing technical achievement, musicianship and the development of individual musicality.

MUSC 210 Applied Music I 1 Credit Hour (0,3)

Individual applied music instruction. For skilled musicians with admission at the discretion of the instructor. May be repeated to a maximum of eight credits per instrument or for voice.

MUSC 220 History Appreciation Music I 4 Credit Hours (4,0)

A survey of music from the Middle Ages to the early 19th century with emphasis on the music of Bach, Handel, Haydn, Mozart and Beethoven. Counts as humanitites credit for general education requirements.

MUSC 221 History Appreciation Music II 4 Credit Hours (4,0)

A survey of music of the 19th and 20th centuries. Counts as humanities credit for general education requirements.

MUSC 235 Music for Elementary Teachers 3 Credit Hours (3,0)

This course is designed to provide an understanding of the philosophy, theories and contemporary issues in music education in the kindergarten through sixth grade classrooms. The student will develop a practical knowledge of music skills and instructional techniques when planning a music curriculum for the elementary classroom.
